TRAVEL AND ACCOMODATION

Verona is well served by all main means of transport available in Northern Italy (roads, railways, airports). Verona is also an ideal starting point for excursions to Venice, Florence or Lake of Garda.

Verona is located roughly midway between the northern Italian cities of Milan and Venice. The nearest airports are Villafranca di Verona (10 km far from the city), Venice, Milan-Bergamo.

Verona has always been a compulsory stop for many travellers in the past. Now it is an important destination for international tourism, attracting each year more than 1,000,000 visitors. Verona is well known all over the world as the setting for Shakespeare's romantic play, Romeo and Juliet. But here you will not only see the famous balcony, but you will be surrounded by 2,000 years of history, by simply walking around the extensive and well preserved city centre.

Although you are free to choose the hotel for your Accomodation, we suggest to book your hotel rooms via Cooperativa Albergatori, by sending an email to the following address: info@veronabooking.com. There are several rooms optioned at the Hotel Maxim (4*) at the special rate of 102,00 euros for double rooms (90 euros for single rooms), including breakfast. The hotel is 5 minutes distant from the Workshop avenue (by taxi). **Please book your rooms by the 5th of August, and indicate that you are participating to the ISCRIM event.**
